I. INTRODUCTION

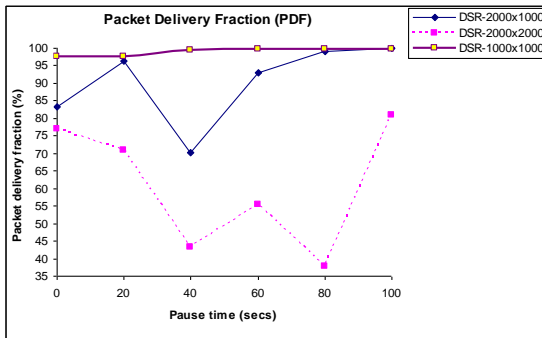


Figure1. Testing data- load current (amperes)

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Figures are to be sequentially numbered in Arabic numerals. The caption must be placed below the figure. Typeset in 8 pt Times New Roman. Long captions are to be justified by the "page-width". Leave one line spacing of 10 points Times New Roman after figure caption complete and next paragraph/text start. Use single spacing between a caption and the text that follows immediately, e.g. **Figure1.** Testing data- load current (amperes).

Tables should be numbered sequentially in the text in Arabic numerals. Captions are to be centralized above the tables. Typeset tables and captions in 8 pt Times Roman with base line skip of 10 pt. Use single spacing between a caption and the text that follows immediately, e.g. **Table1.** Best results. Place table titles above the tables.
